ORDER PERMITTING SERVICE BY POSTING AND MAILING

Upon consideration of Plaintiff’s MOTION FOR ORDER PERMITTING SERVICE BY POSTING AND MAILING, the Court hereby finds as follows:

1. That the Plaintiff caused to be issued a garnishment for child support arrearage, interest and genetic testing fees in this cause of action, which garnishment was served on Garnishee, but not on the Defendant.
2. The Garnishee has or is withholding from Defendant’s check.
3. The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Calhoun County, Alabama, has monies collected from Defendant’s check.

It is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** as follows:

A. Plaintiff’s Motion for Order Permitting Service by Posting and Mailing is hereby **GRANTED** and the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Calhoun County, Alabama, is hereby ordered as follows:

- i) To post a copy of the notice of garnishment and written Court Order authorizing the posting on the Clerk of Circuit Court’s official website and in

a designated and conspicuous location in the Calhoun County Courthouse where this action is pending, for four consecutive weeks; and,

ii) Send by regular U. S. Mail a copy of the posted notice of garnishment to the Defendant at the Defendant's last known address.

B. The Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Order to all parties and/or their attorneys of record.
